YCCC INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ANNUAL BUDGET

Annual Expenses are based on Financial Aid's Independent Off Campus Budget

Tuition and Fees - \$7,036 US dollars

Room and Board - \$9,747 US dollars

Books and Supplies - \$1,400 US dollars

Personal Expenses – \$6,206 US dollars

Total Budget for one year = \$ 24,389 US dollars.

For each dependent add 5728 which includes living and personal expenses

Multiply all amounts X 2 to calculate the total amount for the standard 2-year duration of stay.

Students must provide proof that they have 1-year of expenses immediately available upon admission and show proof of a source of funding for the additional years needed to complete their degree. At YCCC, most degree's take 2 years to complete.
